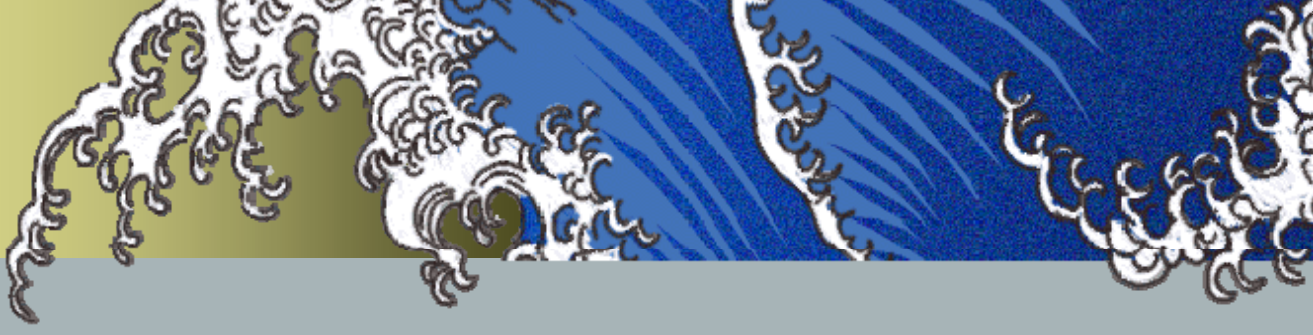


Key Questions
