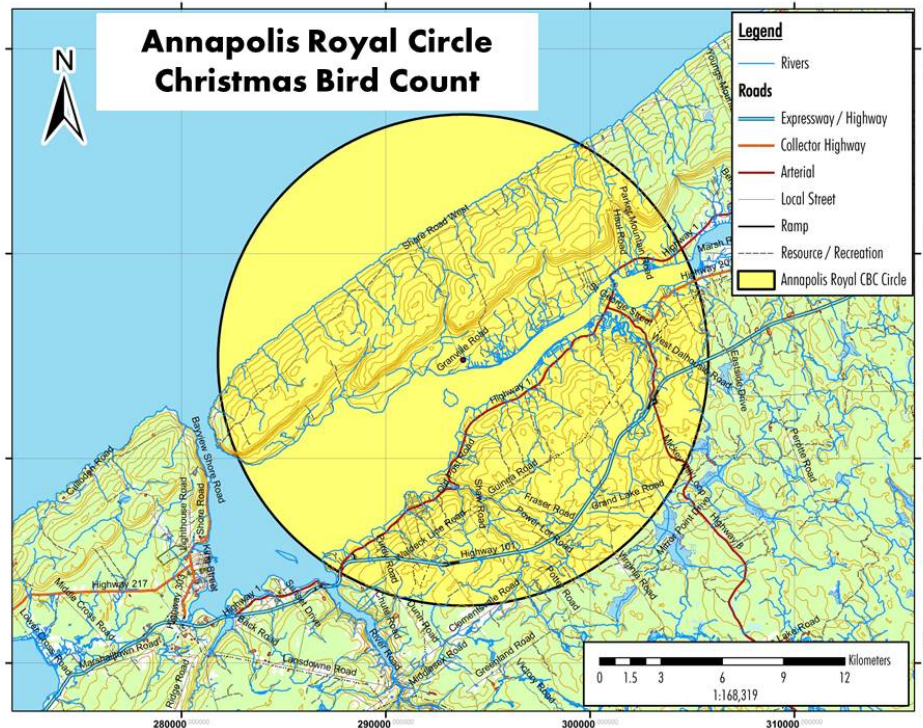

## **Nova Scotia Christmas Bird Count Rare Bird Report Form**
