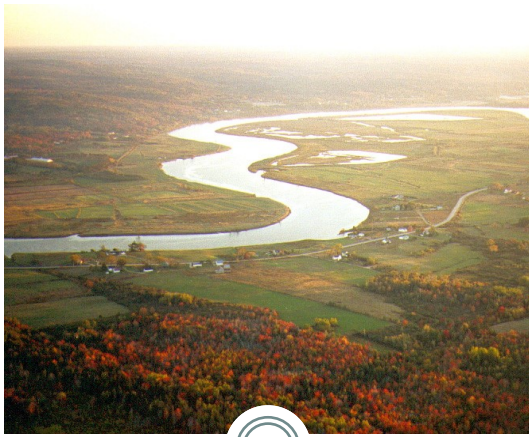

The Clean Annapolis River Project (CARP) is a charitable, community-based, non-governmental organization incorporated in 1990 with a mission to enhance the ecological health of the Annapolis River watershed through science, leadership and community engagement.

CARP takes pride in delivering environmental projects in the Annapolis River watershed that help us attain our vision, mission and strategic goals. CARP works in collaboration with a broad variety of partners, stakeholder groups and community members. Projects are designed to address specific issues affecting our watershed.

### WHAT DOES YOUR MEMBERSHIP SUPPORT?

#### Conservation and Stewardship Programs

#### Hawboldt Environmental Studies Bursary

20% of each membership will be contributed to the Hawboldt Environmental Studies Bursary fund. This bursary is awarded annually to a student graduating from a high school within the watershed, who has enrolled in post-secondary studies within the field of environmental studies.
